### Exchange Student Program

#### Information

- Eligibility
  - Full time student currently enrolled in partner universities
  - Those who can study courses delivered either in English or Korean
- Program Period
  - One or two semesters
- Application Deadline
  - Fall semester (September – December) : May
  - Spring semester (March – June) : November
- Required Documents
  - Official transcript, study plan, etc

### SEOULTECH International Summer School (STISS)

#### Information

- Description
  - FREE program offered for students from partner universities to learn Korean language and understand Korean culture through special lectures and field trips
- Credits : 2 academic credits awarded upon completion
- Timetable
  - Morning Class : Korean Language Courses
  - Afternoon Class : Special Lectures or Half Day Field Trips
- Participants : 90 in total (up to three from each university)
- Period : Middle of July
- Benefit : All free including tuition, dormitory, meals, field trips and airport pick-up service EXCEPT airfare

#### Program Contents

- Basic Korean Language
- Special Lectures
  - Korean Movie Class, Korean Music Class, Taekwondo Class, Korean Cuisines, etc
- Field Trips
  - Korean Palace Tour, Seoul City Tour, etc

### Korean Language Program

#### Information

- Objectives
  - To advance Korean language skills for the full academic courses
  - To understand Korean culture
- Eligibility : A high school diploma or equivalent
- Terms & Hours
  - 4 terms
  - [Spring : 3-5, Summer : 6-8, Fall : 9-11, Winter : 12-2]
  - 200 hours for 10 weeks (per term)
- Time Table : Monday to Friday 9:00-13:00 / 13:30-17:30
- Tuition : approx. USD 1,200 per term

#### Required Documents

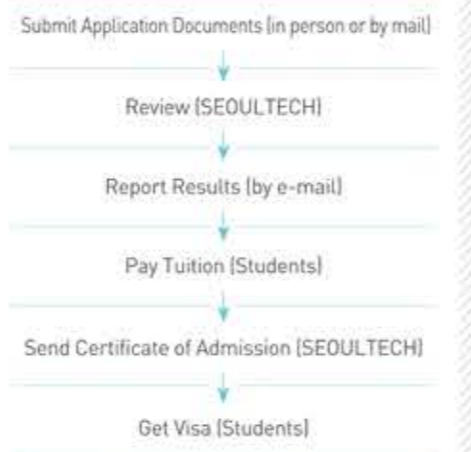
- An application form
- A copy of passport
- A copy of the certificate of graduation and a notarized official transcript (translated either in Korean or English)
- An original certified bank statement of the applicant's account (USD 5,000 or higher)
- Birth / Family Certificate
- A copy of ID card of student's own country
- X-ray result for tuberculosis (For Dormitory)
- An application fee of KRW 50,000(non-refundable)

#### Class Levels

Level 1 ~ 2 (Beginner)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic communication tasks needed in daily Korean life</li> <li>• Basic Korean culture</li> </ul>
Level 3 ~ 4 (Intermediate)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic communication tasks needed in social functions</li> <li>• Minimum Korean skills essential for admission to Korean universities</li> <li>• Various aspects of Korean culture</li> </ul>
Level 5 ~ 6 (Advanced)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Natural communication tasks in daily life and in social functions</li> <li>• Broad and profound understanding of Korean culture and history</li> </ul>

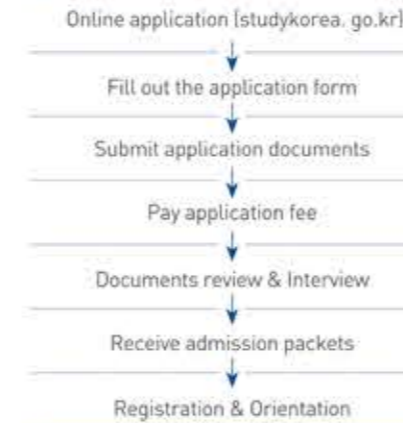
