AIA SAN DIEGO SCHOLARSHIP

NewSchool of Architecture & Design and **American Institute of Architects (AIA) San Diego** have partnered together to launch a scholarship for the top architecture and design professionals interested in pursuing their graduate degrees at NewSchool of Architecture & Design. The annual scholarships of up to \$5,000 are awarded to graduate architecture students who express interest in supporting the mission of the Center for Healthy Environments at NewSchool.

Recently, the American Institute of Architects (AIA) named NewSchool as a charter member of the national Design and Health Research Consortium, which will fund basic research on how design affects public health. The mission of the Center for Healthy Environments at NewSchool is to promote the school's established leadership and expertise in the fields of neuroscience for architecture and healthy urbanism.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The AIA San Diego Scholarship award will be up to \$5,000 (US dollars) per academic year, divided over three quarters. Students must remain in good academic standing, and be continuously enrolled in a NewSchool graduate architecture program.

AUDIENCE

Award is open to New and Continuing Grad students. Participants must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 to qualify.

SUBMISSION

Applicants must submit:

- A one page typed statement describing how, in the applicant's view, architects can design and build projects that promote healthy environments and communities. Applicant should outline specific examples of this, as it relates to neuroscience for architecture and healthy urbanism.
- A portfolio demonstrating design ability or potential, maximum 10 pages
- Work should be compiled into a PDF
- Written materials must be submitted in English, as it is the language of instruction at NewSchool

SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

The Scholarship Committee consists of members of the leadership team of Center for Healthy Environments at NewSchool of Architecture & Design along with the Grad committee, which includes the program chair. The committee will review submittals and make the scholarship selections.

DEADLINE

All material must be sent via e-mail (file to be sent in PDF format) to Scholarships@NewSchoolArch.edu indicating in the subject "AIA San Diego Scholarship".

New student apps only:

Due April 20th

New and continuing student apps:

Due August 17th

Candidates will be informed about the results of the scholarship via email.

- NewSchool is under no obligation to award the scholarship if the projects are deemed to not meet the standards defined by the jury. The jury will judge at its own discretion and its decision is final.
- The Graduate Architecture Scholarship Program (AIA San Diego Scholarship) may not be stackable with some other tuition reductions. Please ask your enrollment advisor for more details.
- Receiving a scholarship does not guarantee admission to NewSchool. All applicants will have to apply and meet all the admission requirements in order to be admitted.
- Award amount when combined with all other institutional awards and/or financial guarantees cannot exceed 100% tuition and fees on a student account for scholarship to be applied.
- Projects and essays submitted previously to NewSchool for other scholarship opportunities will not be accepted. Work must be original.
