



**SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT
2018-19 ACADEMIC YEAR**

TO ALL NSAD STUDENTS:

NewSchool of Architecture & Design annually awards the President's Award to outstanding students in all of our degree programs. All eligible students are encouraged to apply by the deadlines noted below. Scholarship awards are made for varying amounts, generally up to \$7,500 with specific amounts dependent on the number of recommended applicants and the amount of funds available. Scholarship funds are disbursed quarterly during the academic year. Students are required to be full-time.

Scholarship and leadership are the two most important criteria used in determining recipients. In addition, applicants will be reviewed for the significance of their work as recognized by the faculty and/or other professionals, and service that leads to the betterment of NewSchool.

Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than **4:00pm** on the deadline date.

Deadlines:

- Fall- Friday, August 17th
- Winter- Friday, December 7th

Minimum requirements:

- Have attended 3 quarters of attendance at NewSchool
- GPA of 3.5

The applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and final awards are expected to be made shortly following the due dates.

3. **Letter(s) of Recommendation:** Please provide a letter from at least one of the following: professional, academic or community reference, with name, position, and contact information as well as your relationship to the reference.
