The California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) requires the Financial Aid office to verify that you have met the eligibility requirements of the Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant before receiving the award. Your Cal Grant is on HOLD by CSAC for AB840 verification.

Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant Requirements

To receive the transfer entitlement Cal Grant you must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Graduate from a California High School
- ✓ Be a California resident at time of High School graduation
- ✓ Verified Community College GPA of at least 2.4
- ✓ Attended and completed at least one term at a California Community College and be transferring to a qualifying California Institution that offers Bachelor’s degrees.
- ✓ No more than 27 years of age by Dec 31 in the year of first award.

*****Submit this form with all requested documents to the Financial Aid Office as soon as possible. Failure to complete this verification could cause you to lose eligibility to receive Cal Grant awards.*****

To Clear HOLD:

Option #1 – Applies if you were 18 or older when you graduated high school or completed an equivalency.

Submit proof of graduation from a California High School in the form of one of the following: Final Official copy of your California High School Transcript, GED, Copy of High School Diploma with graduation date, or Copy of High School proof of equivalency.

Option #2 – Applies if you were 17 or younger when you graduated high school or completed an equivalency.

- 1) **Submit proof of graduation from a California High School** in the form of one of the following: Final Official copy of your California High School Transcript, GED, Copy of High School Diploma with graduation date, or Copy of High School proof of equivalency.
- 2) **AND Submit proof of California residency** at time of High School graduation with one of the following:
 - a. **Copy of parent’s** (or legal guardian’s) **California State Tax Return** for tax year immediately prior to graduation (2010 taxes if you graduated in 2011).
 - b. **If your parent did not file a California State Tax Return**, you may supply one of the following for the calendar year immediately prior to you high school graduation:
 - California lease or rental agreement
 - California utility bill
 - California voter registration
 - California auto registration
 - California bank account record
 - California insurance record

OR- for military:

Submit a copy of **your parent’s military records verifying relocation orders** from California dated prior to your high school graduation or its equivalent **AND** at least one of the documents listed above for a period that **predates** the relocation orders.
