Option 1: Direct Placement in Third Year

For students who have completed the necessary prerequisites.

Option 2: Fall Quarter Studio [Lecture]

For students who have two years of equivalent studio credits, but are missing required lecture course credits.

To make up missing lecture credits, take a special Fall Quarter studio focused on building systems and environmental systems (six lecture credits), fully integrated with a Human-Centered Design Thinking studio. These students will then move on to join the normal flow of third year students in Winter Quarter.

Option 3: Summer Quarter Studio [Studio + Lecture]

For students who are missing both studio and lecture course credits.

To make up missing studio and lecture credits, take a special Summer Quarter studio focused on building systems and environmental systems (six studio and six lecture credits), fully integrated with a Human-Centered Design Thinking studio. These students will then move on to join the normal flow of third year students in Fall Quarter.
