

SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT 2019-20 ACADEMIC YEAR

TO INCOMING NSAD STUDENTS:

NewSchool of Architecture & Design annually awards the President's Award to outstanding students in all of our degree programs. All eligible students are encouraged to apply by the deadlines noted below. Scholarship awards are made for varying amounts, generally up to \$7,500, with specific amounts dependent on the number of qualified applicants and the amount of funds available. Scholarship funds are disbursed quarterly during the academic year. Students are required to be full-time.

Scholarship and leadership are the two most important criteria used in determining recipients. In addition, applicants will be reviewed for the significance of their work as recognized by the faculty and/or other professionals.

Applications are reviewed on a first come first served basis by the Scholarship Committee and award notices are typically sent within 2 weeks of submission. Awards will continue to be made until scholarship funds are exhausted or until the final deadline date below.

Deadlines:

- Fall Friday, September 20th
- Winter Friday, December 20th

Minimum requirements:

• Admitted to NewSchool with a GPA of 3.5 or above
