Campus Access:

The NewSchool campus has been inaccessible to faculty staff, and students as of March 15, 2020.

- The campus is will remain inaccessible to students, visitors, faculty, and staff – with limited exceptions – until further notice.
- All NewSchool operations are being conducted remotely to the fullest extent possible.
- NewSchool employees will continue to work under guidance from their department directors, with the expectation that they will continue to work remotely until further notice is provided.
