Marvin left our world with a gentle and peaceful passage, much as we knew him. Marvin's laugh filled a room with happiness, and his presence will continue to be felt around NewSchool and the community he touched. We are incredibly blessed to have learned from him and been inspired by him. The world has lost an exceptional human being and a leader in architecture, design, and higher education.

Marvin brought a very special sensitivity to design thinking, one that was focused on the human experience. His book, *Being Creative: Being a Creative*, represents his extremely personalized account of becoming "human-centered by design," his architectural design mantra, and a belief he carried throughout his career as an architect and educator.
