

Update: December 15, 2021

We have evaluated our campus health and safety measures and will continue to keep the following guidelines in place through the remainder of the fall quarter.

In accordance with the CDC and California officials, please read the guidelines below to ensure you are prepared to return to campus. Our health and safety protocols will be in effect for the first 5-weeks of the fall quarter to ensure the safety of all our students, faculty, and staff. As we receive updates, we will communicate these guidelines.

Campus Health and Safety Guidelines:

- All students on campus are required to wear a mask inside the building at all times. This includes classrooms, common areas, and campus services. Masks are also available on campus.
- Although we have increased our cleaning protocols for your safety, students are encouraged to wipe down their workspace at the beginning of the class. Sanitizing stations are available outside of the classroom for their convenience.
- Multi-stall restrooms are now single-use restrooms to reduce risk in more confined spaces.
- Temperature check stations are located at the front of the Hang Ten and Main Building to enhance safety measures on campus.
