

# Opportunity Award Scholarship **2023-24**ACADEMIC YEAR

#### TO ALL NEWSCHOOL STUDENTS:

NEWSCHOOL awards the Opportunity Award to outstanding students in all of our degree programs who are experiencing a temporary financial hardship. All eligible students are encouraged to apply. Scholarship awards are made for varying amounts, generally up to

\$10,000 with specific amounts dependent on the number of qualified applicants, amount of student's financial need and the amount of funds available. Scholarship funds are disbursed per semester during the academic year.

Financial need and proof of temporary hardship are the two most important criteria used in determining recipients. Students who choose not to borrow Federal student loans that they are otherwise eligible for are not eligible to apply for the Opportunity Award.

### **Minimum requirements:**

- Have attended 2 semesters at NewSchool
- GPA of 2.5 for undergraduates
- A completed 2023-24 FAFSA with an expected family contribution number (EFC) below 10,000 is required.
- Students selected for FAFSA Verification will need to submit all required verification documents prior to applying for the Opportunity Award.

- 2. 3rd party documentation.

All students must submit 3<sup>rd</sup> party documentation to validate claims made in statement of need. Examples include statement from employer regarding recent job loss or receipts for recent unexpected expenses (car repair, medical bills etc.).
