

# NewSchool Update: COVID-19 (Coronavirus Disease 2019) Information

**Update: 2/1/21** 

After significant research and consideration, NewSchool's leadership team has confirmed that all **Spring 2021 quarter academic courses will be delivered solely online**. This remains the best path forward in ensuring the safety and welfare of NewSchool's campus community and our goal of providing a quality educational experience for our students. NewSchool is committed to providing an engaged academic and student experience through the digital environment.

Although courses will be delivered fully online, we will resume offering various campus operations in a limited capacity while remaining in full compliance with national, state, and local policies and guidelines, similar to Fall 2020 quarter campus operations. See below for more details.

We are all eager to return to our past operational activities as soon as it is deemed safe to do so. NewSchool leadership is considering possible hybrid class modalities starting in Summer 2021, and we are hopeful to be able to return to normal campus operations in Fall 2021.

#### SINGLE LOCATION PICK-UP WILL RESUME ON FEBRUARY 9:

We are pleased to resume Single Location Pick-Up starting on Tuesday, February 9, 2021. Single Location Pick-Up is available to students in the local area for services from the Technology Core, Library, and Materials Lab. Students can check out books, print academic materials, or submit files to make models (with limitations) through email requests and reservations to pick up on campus.

Note that NewSchool has implemented health and safety protocols, and all individuals coming to campus for any purpose will be expected to follow those protocols, which are outlined in the reservation system and in the confirmation email you receive after making an appointment.

## **Technology Core**

Students may request printing services for academic coursework. Printing requests must be made 48-hours in advance. To request prints, you must submit a Technology Core Job Submissions Form, accessible <a href="here">here</a>.

#### **Materials Lab**

Students may submit files for models to be produced from the laser cutter. All models will be created using 18x32 3/16 cardboard (10 sheets max per student). To request models, please email the Materials Lab at matlab@newschoolarch.edu.

Students may check out books from the Library using the online reservation system <a href="here">here</a>. Once you find the book(s) you would like to pick up, click the square icon with the green arrow to place it on hold. A limit of 10 items may be picked up at a time.

Aside from the services listed above, the NewSchool campus will not be open for any other services for the Winter 2021 or Spring 2021 Quarters, remaining in remote operations. NewSchool leadership has made this decision to protect the safety and welfare of NewSchool's campus community during the COVID-19 pandemic.
