- **Adult Learning Environment:** The student will be participating in college-level courses designed for adult learners. Course content, discussions, and materials will not be modified or censored for minor students.
- **Academic Rigor and Course Load:** The student is restricted to enrolling in a maximum of two (2) courses per term to ensure a successful balance with high school responsibilities. The coursework requires college-level dedication, time management, and study skills.
- **Academic Standing:** The student must maintain a minimum cumulative collegiate Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0. Falling below this standard will result in academic warning, probation, or suspension from the dual enrollment program.
- **Catalog:** Information about NewSchool of Architecture and Design is published in a school catalog that contains a description of policies, procedures, and other information about the school. NewSchool of Architecture and Design reserves the right to change any provision of the catalog at any time. Notice of changes will be



communicated in a revised catalog, an addendum or supplement to the catalog, or other written format. Students are expected to read and be familiar with the information contained in the school catalog, in any revisions, supplements and addenda to the catalog, and with all school policies.
